1. **CALL TO ORDER BY THE CHAIR** (Non-Action Item.)
2. **VERIFICATION OF NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE WITH OPEN MEETING LAW**
(Non-Action Item.) The Chair of the Nevada State Board of Fire Services will verify compliance has been met in accordance with Nevada Open Meeting Law (NRS 241.)
3. **ROLL CALL AND INTRODUCTIONS** (Non-action Item.)
4. **PUBLIC COMMENT** (Non-Action Item.) No action may be taken on matters raised in context with this Agenda item prior to inclusion of the matter itself as an action item on a future Agenda. Public comments are limited to three (3) minutes. Comments will not be restricted based on viewpoint.
5. **ELECTION OF A STATE BOARD OF FIRE SERVICES CHAIRPERSON** (Discussion/For Possible Action.) Pursuant to NRS 477.073, the members of the State Board of Fire Services will elect a Chairperson to serve a one (1) year term.
6. **APPROVAL OF THE JUNE 21, 2018 MEETING MINUTES** (Discussion/For Possible Action.) The members of the Board of Fire Services will approve/make necessary changes to the June 21, 2018 minutes submitted.
7. **MODIFICATIONS TO SCHOOL FIRE ALARM SYSTEMS** (Discussion/For Possible Action.) Possible action is for the Board to discuss and potentially provide the Chair with a position on alterations to the Fire Code regarding K-12 school fire alarms due to active assailant/hostile event concerns. Any position so provided by the Board may be used for any Legislative testimony by the Chair or Board members when representing the Board of Fire Services.

8. **HEIGHT OF BUILDINGS TO MEET THE NEVADA HIGH RISE BUILDING REQUIREMENTS** (Discussion/For Possible Action.) Possible action is for the Board to discuss and potentially provide the Chair with a position on the height of buildings to be considered a high rise; either the current Nevada standard of 55 feet or the base fire code height of 75 feet. Any position so provided by the Board may be used for any Legislative testimony by the Chair or Board members when representing the Board of Fire Services.
9. **ADOPTION OF A WILDLAND URBAN INTERFACE CODE** (Discussion/For Possible Action.) Possible action is to discuss and possibly provide the Chair with a Board position on the adoption of the Wildland Urban Interface Codes by local municipalities and the State Fire Marshal providing the Chair with an official recommendation or adoption. Any position so provided by the Board may be used for any Legislative testimony by the Chair or Board members when representing the Board of Fire Services.
10. **REQUIRED TRAINING FOR FIREFIGHTERS** (Discussion/For Possible Action.) Possible action is for the Board to discuss and potentially provide the Chair with an official position on requiring a minimum level of training prior to an individual being able to respond as a firefighter. Any position so provided by the Board may be used for any Legislative testimony by the Chair or Board members when representing the Board of Fire Services.
11. **STATEWIDE RESILIENCY STRATEGY** (Discussion/For Possible Action.) Possible action is for the Board to discuss and potentially provide a recommendation for the State to adopt the Homeland Security Working Group's resiliency strategy. Any position so provided by the Board may be used for any Legislative testimony by the Chair or Board members when representing the Board of Fire Services.
12. **REPORTS FROM BOARD MEMBERS CONCERNING THEIR VARIOUS CONSTITUENT GROUPS THEY REPRESENT ON THE BOARD** (Non-Action Item) Report from Board members concerning their various constituent groups they represent on the Board or any of the various committees/assignments they are involved with as liaison to the Board or Fire Services and the public.
