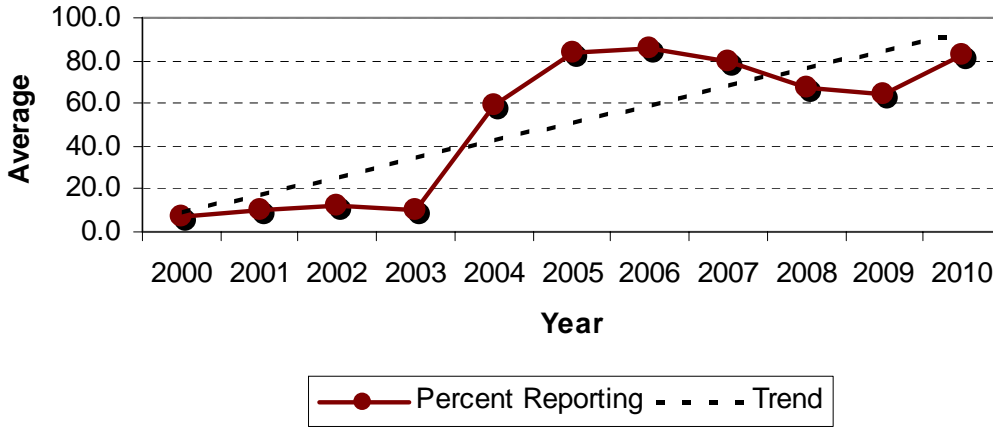

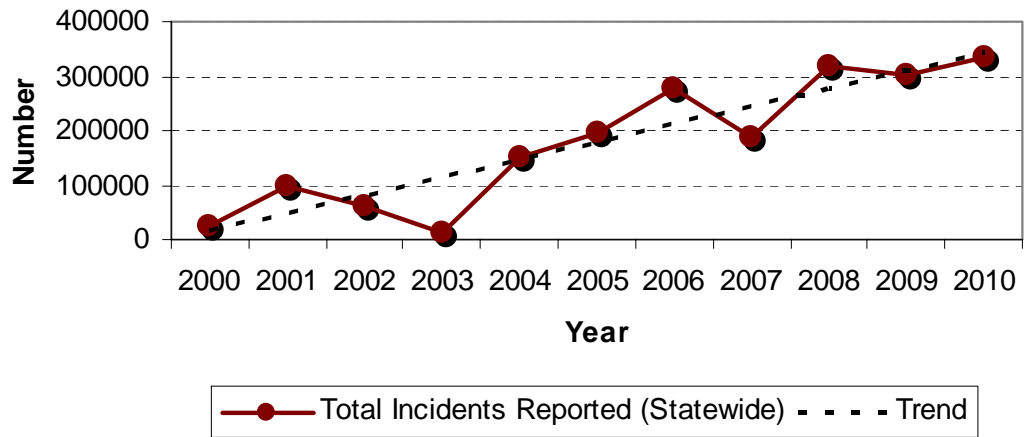

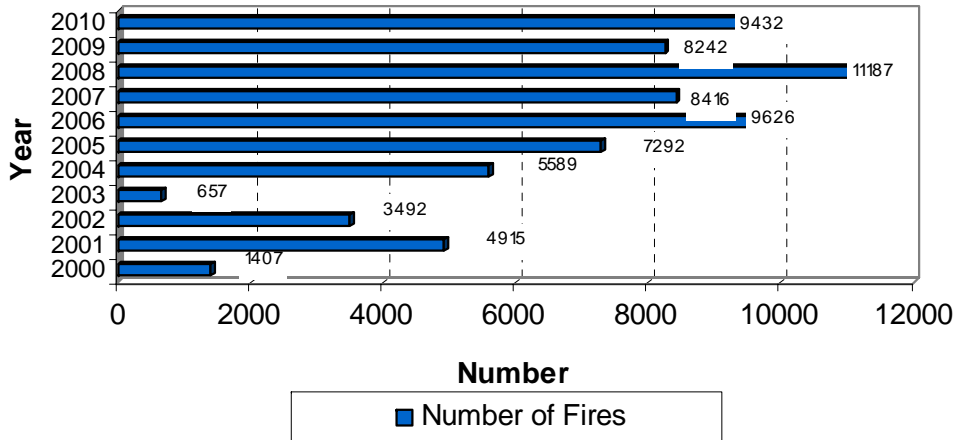
Reporting Departments by Year



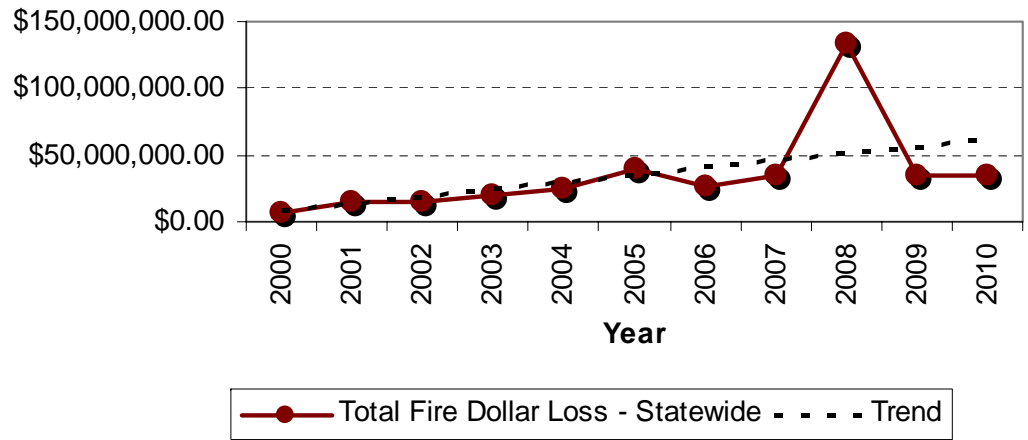
Total Reported Incidents by Year



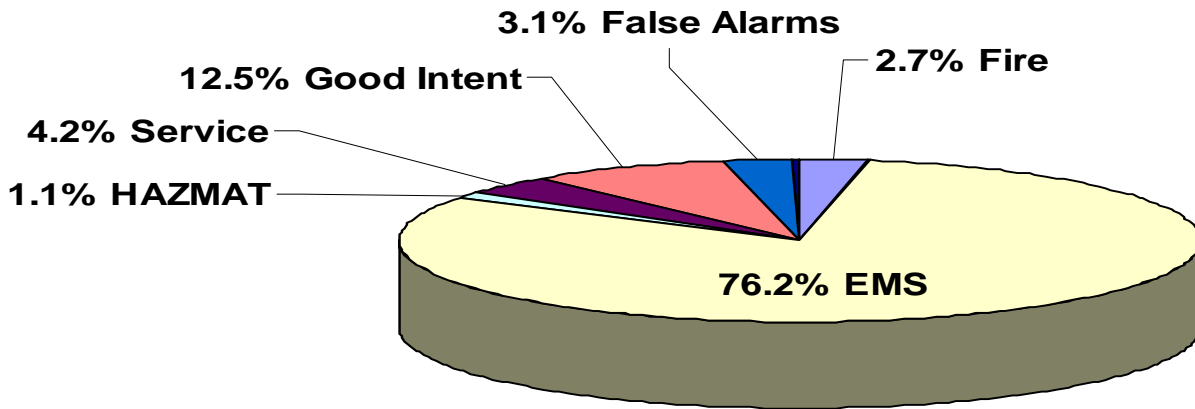
All Fires Reported by Year



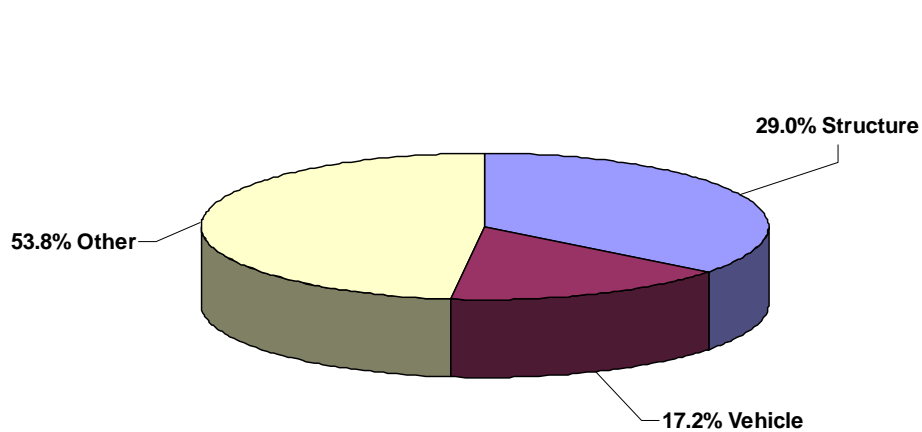
Total Fire Dollar Loss - Statewide



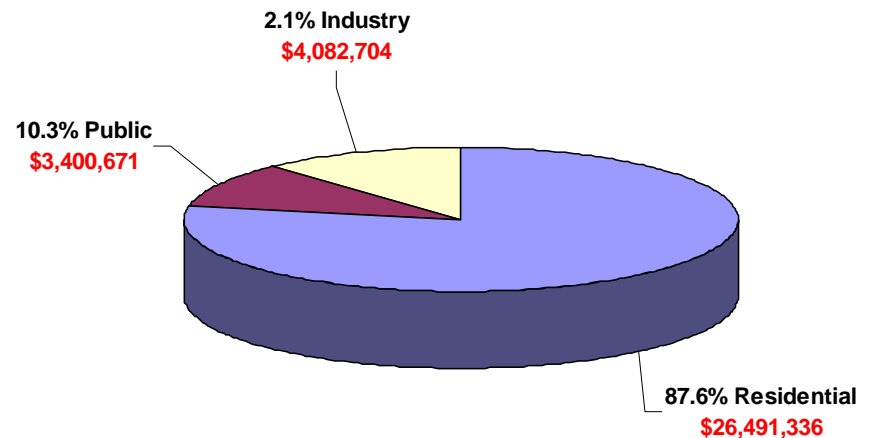
