When requesting information, ensure you are using the exact name and/or address as our database is case sensitive. We will review each request to the best of our ability, but we cannot be held responsible for misspellings, wrong addresses or incorrect information.

Once your request is received, we will process the request usually within three business days and send an invoice via email or US Mail, (your choice). Once payment is received (we do not accept cash, only checks or e-checks) and processed through the State Fire Marshal Financial Services Bureau, we will email or mail (your choice) the requested information.
