 - Determine if chemical is combustible
 - Identify correct name of chemical by using ERG
- 3. Use the ERG, SDS, shipping papers with emergency response information and other approved reference sources to identify hazardous materials/WMD and their potential fire, explosion, and health hazards
 - Identify hazards of chemical (Health, Explosive, etc.)
