#### **Chief Moore:**

Key fire related BDRs/legislation thus far are to follow. Highlights represent drafted legislation. I am happy to send you links of the bills. Currently, 968 BDRs are on the table. 80<sup>th</sup> Nevada Legislature begins February 4, 2019.

- R-155: Creates Western Regional Fire and Emergency Response Commission (Kieckhefer)
- AB 4 (21-459): Authorizes cities incorporated pursuant to statue to create a
  district to provide fire protection services. (City of Reno)
- SB11 (42-460): Revises provision governing adoption of Fire and building codes by cities. (City of Las Vegas)

- AB48 (20-485): Provides counties with discretion in manner of funding fire protection and emergency services. (Nye County)
- R-509: Directs the Legislative Commission to appoint an interim study concerning wildfires (Legislative Committee on Public Lands)
