Chief Moore:

Key fire related BDRs/legislation thus far are to follow. Highlights represent drafted legislation. I am happy to send you links of the bills. Currently, 968 BDRs are on the table. 80th Nevada Legislature begins February 4, 2019.

- **R-155:** Creates Western Regional Fire and Emergency Response Commission (Kieckhefer)
- **AB 4 (21-459):** Authorizes cities incorporated pursuant to statute to create a district to provide fire protection services. (City of Reno)
- **SB11 (42-460):** Revises provision governing adoption of Fire and building codes by cities. (City of Las Vegas) *plans*
- **AB48 (20-485):** Provides counties with discretion in manner of funding fire protection and emergency services. (Nye County) *plans/Tracy*
- **R-509:** Directs the Legislative Commission to appoint an interim study concerning wildfires (Legislative Committee on Public Lands) *plans*

Other noteworthy BDRs include:
